

Creating a Basic Search from the Home Page

1. On the Home Page, enter your search terms in the **Find** box and click **Search**.



2. Searchasaurus performs a search and displays a Result List.



3. To view a specific source type (for example, only Magazines), click the source type icon.

Browse by Topic

1. If you want to search for articles about a certain topic, you can click on a **topic** (for example, **History**) on the Home Page. *Searchasaurus* displays a list of subtopics.
2. Click a subtopic (for example, **Pioneers**) item until *Searchasaurus* displays a Result List.

Note: Sometimes there is more than one level of subtopics that exist within a topic. For example, **Animals** -> **Mammals** -> **Deer/Elephant/Giraffe/Moose/Pig** etc.

Top Searches

The most frequent searches are automatically displayed in the **Top Searches** area on *Searchasaurus*. To find articles about a top search, simply click the **link** and *Searchasaurus* displays a list of articles.

Fun Facts
